Rentas de Fincas Reserva 2007 is the latest release of this prestige Rioja, which is made only during the best vintages. This wine is a labor of love, the result of a collaboration between the importer Ramón Romero and the winemaker Pilar García-Granero, one of the best-known enologists in Spain and one of the few women to attain such a high status in the Spanish winemaking community.

GRAPE VARIETIES: Tempranillo 80%, Garnacha 10%, Mazuelo 10%.

TASTING NOTES:

A dark purple wine with violet highlights. Blackberry, candied cherry and ripe strawberry on the nose, with vanilla, baking spices, sandalwood and slate notes. Silky in the mouth, the wine overflows with abundant dark berry and cherry. The tannins are well integrated and mouth-coating. The wine resolves to a lingering berry-pie finish.

WINEMAKING:

12 months (DD)

Rentas de Fincas Reserva 2007 underwent a two-stage fermentation in stainless steel tanks. The wine was aged 12 months in new barrels of American and French oak before spending two years cellar aging in the bottle.
